Partnership Eclectic Tournament 2024 Rules

- Tournament starts in April and terminates at the end of November.
- Select your partner, sign up on the registration sheet and place your \$10 per team registration fee in an envelope and deliver to Loanne Rube or Geri Wilk before play or at lunch. Sign-ups begin February 29.
- A team consists of 2 players of any combination of tees. (i.e. #2 and #2, #2 and #2/3, or #2/3 and #2/3). Once registered, no change in tee assignments is allowed.
- THE GAME: You and your partner will keep track individually of your lowest gross score per hole on up to 8 EC play dates on your EC scorecard (yellow). The EC chair will choose the lowest score between the two partners for each hole to create a team score. Your team handicap and flights will be based on the July 1 handicap. Team handicaps will be determined by the total of both handicaps divided by two. If the spread between partners is more than 8 strokes, the higher handicap will be adjusted down to comply with the 8- stroke maximum spread. Lowest net partnership score wins.
- Play any 8 games out of the following 14 dates. April 4, 11, 25 May 2, 30 June 27 July 18, 25 Aug 1, 22, 29

Sept 26 October 10, 17

- On the day you play, collect your Eclectic Scorecard (yellow) from the EC box on the registration table. The first day you play record all your gross scores on the first line. Each day you play, your card must be attested and dated by someone in your foursome, not your EC partner. Return the card to the after-play EC box. On your subsequent EC play days you will only record a score on those holes where you have improved your score for that hole. You must hole out on any hole that is to be included on your EC scorecard.
- You must take your EC scorecard before beginning play and you must return the attested and dated scorecard to the after-play box after each round. Do not take your scorecard home. If you fail to return your attested and dated card after a day of play you will be disqualified for that day. If you take your scorecard out of the EC box, this qualifies as an EC round and you must have your score attested and dated even if you do not improve on the score for any hole on that day.
- Mid season results, using the July 1 handicaps, will be posted in the posting room and flights will be determined. The tournament completes at the end of November. Final results and awards will be made at the Holiday Luncheon in December. Awards are cash.
