HOW TO ADJUST YOUR SCORE BEFORE POSTING

- 1. You must know your Course Handicap to determine what score you will post after your round. Check your current Index against the course rating and slope chart for the course you played.
- 2. You will post a Double Bogey **plus** any strokes you get on that Hole, based on its ranking.
 - a. Par of the hole + 2 strokes + any handicap stroke(s) that the player receives on that hole.
- 3. NCGA recommends posting Hole by Hole to ensure accuracy of score adjustment.
- 4. A <u>minimum of 10 holes</u> must be played for an 18-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes.
 - a. Enter your score, hole by hole, and the computer will fill in the "expected score" for each remaining hole.
- 5. All 9 holes must be played for a 9-hole score to be acceptable.
